
Prevent Opioid Deaths









- Keep medicine out of children's sight and reach
- Dispose of unused medicine
- Do not combine opioids with similar medicine or alcohol
- Do not take medicine prescribed to others
- Signs of Opioid Overdose: Slow or no breaths, noisy breathing, very small pupils
- Take Action
- Call 911 if someone cannot be awakened
- Use Naloxone (if available)
- Seek professional treatment
- Get support from family, friends and doctors
- Keep naloxone handy
- Avoid medicines that contain opioids or similar medicine
