Full Spectrum of Conditions Treated

Our clinic services address many problems that may be encountered during breastfeeding, including evaluation and management of:

- Problems with latch
- Sore nipples and breast pain
- Slow weight gain in the infant
- Low milk supply
- Tongue-tie
- Nipple and breast infections, including mastitis and yeast infection
- Breastfeeding multiples
- Complex breastfeeding challenges

Clinic Visits

The clinic is designed to meet the needs of both mother and infant at a single visit. At the visit, mom and baby will be registered as patients and assessed. We evaluate both mother and baby and bill insurance for each assessment.

Most appointments last 90 minutes, giving us time to observe a breastfeeding session and assess the baby's weight before and after feeding. We schedule longer visits for certain situations, such as mothers with twins or triplets. We will work with the mother to design a detailed, individualized feeding plan.

To Make a Referral

Healthcare providers can refer families to the clinic by calling 513-636-2326. Communication with the primary care provider of both mother and infant is a top priority. With the mother's permission, a copy of the electronic visit record will be faxed to the primary providers of both mother and infant within two to three days of the visit.

To Make an Appointment

Appointments for all four locations can be scheduled by calling: 513-636-2326. We strive to schedule visits within one to three business days from the initial call, as we understand the urgency of breastfeeding concerns.
