Our patients may need to return to the hospital if they develop an infection or fever. Thanks to cooperation between Cincinnati Children's CBDI and the Emergency Department, we are able to treat infections rapidly, even faster than recommended health care guidelines.

Our Hematology/Oncology/Blood and Marrow Transplant outpatient clinic and day hospital have made great strides over the last three years in the care of immune-compromised patients with fever. We have met and surpassed the gold standard of administering an antibiotic to these patients within one hour of their arrival to our area.

As a result of the lessons learned and applied by the CBDI outpatient team, many of the same processes have been adopted in the Emergency Department. Patients who require antibiotics in off-hours (evenings and weekends) through the Emergency Department now receive them the majority of the time in less than one hour.

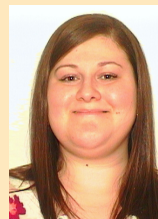
