Friday August 2nd & Friday August 9th * 9:00-3:30PM  Cost \$50 per participant to cover the cost of a book and supplemental materials.	Understanding Behavior in Individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorders	This 2-day workshop is for <b>professionals</b> who work with individuals with ASD. The focus of the workshop will be on fundamental behavioral principles including functions of behavior, preventative strategies, reinforcement, and visual supports.  *Participants must attend the 1 <sup>st</sup> day in order to attend the 2 <sup>nd</sup> day.
Monday August 5th 5:30-7:30PM Cost \$0	HOW TO HELP REGULATE SENSORY SYSTEMS OF INDIVIDUALS WITH ASD	This 2-hr session will focus on common sensory sensitivities demonstrated by individuals with ASD and practical strategies used to address these sensitivities.
Wed August 14th 4:00-6:00PM  Cost \$10 per participant to cover cost of materials.	MAKE IT, TAKE IT: VISUAL SUPPORTS FOR AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS	This 2-hr session will focus on how to make and use visual supports for the home, school, and community. Attendees will be able to take materials made in session.
Fri August 23rd 9:00-3:30PM Cost \$0	GETTING STARTED: WHAT TO DO AFTER RECEIVING THE DIAGNOSIS	This day-long workshop is for families with a child who has been diagnosed with ASD within the past year. The workshop covers basic information such as community and financial resources, family coping, and some basic intervention strategies.
Tues September 10 <sup>th</sup> 5:00-7:00PM Cost \$0	PLEASE JUST GO TO SLEEP: ADDRESSING SLEEP PROBLEMS IN CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS WITH ASD	This 2-hour session will focus on sleep problems in individuals with ASD and tips for how to successfully address these problems.
Fri September 20th 9:00-3:30PM Cost \$0	AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS: WHEN BEHAVIOR IS A CHALLENGE	This day-long workshop is for <b>families</b> who want strategies for working with their child with ASD, including a focus on positive ways of dealing with behaviors.
Wed September 25th 5:30-7:30PM Cost \$0	NOW WHICH PILE DID HE PUT THAT IN? BUILDING ORGANIZATIONAL SKILLS IN INDIVIDUALS WITH ASD	This 2-hr session will focus on deficits often seen in individuals with ASD including difficulties with organizing, planning, initiating work, and staying on task as well as strategies to address these deficits.
