

Meet Damien Reynaud, PhD



Damien Reynaud, PhD, is an experimental hematologist who recently joined the Stem Cell Program at the Cancer and Blood Diseases Institute. His work focuses on the mechanisms that control the generation of blood cells, particularly during early childhood.

Dr. Reynaud was trained as an experimental hematologist at the University of Chicago and comes to us from the University of California, San Francisco.

Protected from pathogens in the womb, babies progressively develop their own immune system after birth. An accident during the maturation of the immune system at this stage could lead to leukemia such as acute lymphoid leukemia (ALL). Dr. Reynaud's laboratory is seeking to identify the cues that control the normal production of immune cells in children and understand how their deregulation contributes to leukemia development. The ultimate goal of his research is to uncover new therapies that can be used to improve the outcome of ALL and other diseases.

Dr. Reynaud's research recently received financial support from the CCHMC Trustee Grant Award. Welcome Damien!

Cincinnati Children's Named 2013 Most Wired

Cincinnati Children's has been named one of Health Care's Most Wired by Hospitals & Health Networks magazine for the third year in a row.

As a Most Wired hospital, Cincinnati Children's is a leader in the adoption, implementation and use of information technology in health care. Among the key findings this year:

- * Sixty-nine percent of Most Wired hospitals and 60 percent of all surveyed hospitals report that medication orders are entered electronically by physicians. This represents an increase from 27 percent in 2004.
- * Seventy-one percent of Most Wired hospitals have an electronic disease registry to identify and manage gaps in care across a population.
- * Sixty-six percent of Most Wired hospitals share patient discharge data with affiliated hospitals.
