

CBDI Patient and Family Wellness Center – Here to Meet Your Needs



A \$500,000 Pledge for Research from Sophie's Angel Run

The organizers of Sophie's Angel Run, an annual 5K walk/run that raises money for pediatric brain tumor research at the CBDI, have signed a pledge to bring their total donations to \$500,000. In recognition of this tremendous contribution, a playroom being constructed in the south wing of our inpatient center will be dedicated in honor of the volunteers of Sophie's Angel Run.

\$250,000 of these donations have been granted to CBDI researchers Lionel Chow and Ronald Waclaw for their research into a new way to treat high-grade glioma, a form of brain cancer. Their project will investigate a combination of treatments that may turn off abnormal signals and stop tumor cells from growing. If successful in the lab this treatment could be tested in patients fairly quickly.

We are extremely grateful to the Meinhart family, founders of Sophie's Angel Run, who, in memory of their daughter Sophie, dedicate so much time and energy to finding a cure for pediatric brain tumors.
