ITEMS DISCUSSED

OM Update

1. There are 169 patients enrolled to date. Our goal is to recruit 240 patients. Anyone wishing to participate, please call Bob Siegel or Michele Kiely. There is a limit of 40 patients per site.
2. ADD/ADHD Grant  
The grant has been finalized and will be mailed to AAP on November 1, 2001. We will hear in January whether the grant is funded or not. We will go ahead with the ADD community pediatrician questionnaire before the first of the year. Debbie Sakelos, CPRG Secretary, will coordinate the mailings.
3. Flu Study  
The CPRG has decided not to do the flu antigen study due to time constraints and other studies going on.
4. NAMCS  
Many members have agreed to participate in the NAMCS. For those who agreed to participate, you will be paid for your participation in this project. The NAMCS was revised to reflect that all participants are primary care practitioners. (The NAMCS was originally designed for all ambulatory care practitioners.) The survey has been renamed PRINS. There are two questionnaires to fill out – PRINS 1 and PRINS 2. PRINS 1 is a clinician interview form (demographic data about the clinician). PRINS 2 is the patient encounter form. The PRINS 1 form will be filled out one time only. Physician/Clinician will need to fill out 30 PRINS 2 forms in order to be paid.
5. Future Studies  
The group talked about future studies for CPRG. There is an overall interest in hypertension/obesity in young children. Steve Daniels, MD will be invited to our next meeting to give us some insight.
