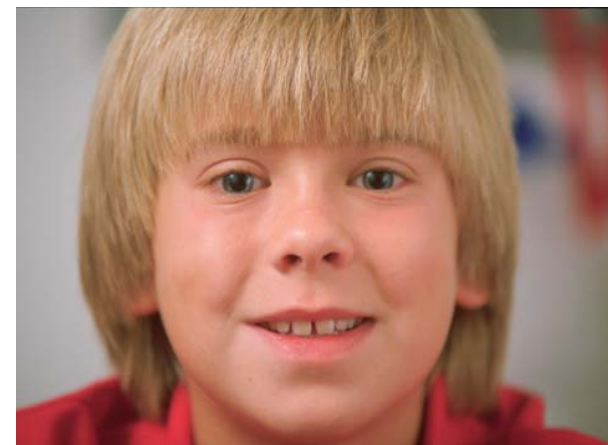

Conference Purpose

Eosinophilic gastrointestinal disorders are increasingly recognized but are often misdiagnosed resulting in long delays before proper therapy is instituted. This half-day conference is for physicians, nurses, social workers, and other members of care teams treating patients (adult or pediatric) with EGID.

Participants will gain knowledge about the diagnosis and therapy of eosinophilic gastrointestinal disorders, including novel therapies.

Conference Objectives

1. List diagnostic criteria for eosinophilic esophagitis suggested in the American Gastroenterology Association's Consensus Statement.
2. Discuss similarities and differences between gastro-esophageal reflux disease and eosinophilic esophagitis.
3. Describe tests useful to identify allergy.
4. Enumerate various therapeutic options and resources for patients who have EGID.
