


# Example of Front Page Orders

## NOTE

These are front page orders on the computerized order entry (COE) system used at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center.

1. "I" =include as default order for all patients. Can be changed by physician as appropriate.

"X" (exclude indicates optional depending on patient factors).

4. Additional Directions is used to provide further detail for specific order.
