Pediatric Anorectal and Colorectal Surgical Problems

A Comprehensive Surgical and Management Workshop

Course Description

This course is designed for pediatric surgeons, urologists, gynecologists and gastroenterologists, as well as pediatric nurses managing patients with colorectal issues. In addition to lectures and case discussions, it also includes live demonstrations of the surgical repair of the most frequent types of anorectal defects, illustrating the spectrum of anorectal malformations. (ARM)

At the conclusion of the course, participants will be able to:

- Understand the principles of diagnosis and management of anorectal defects.
- Discuss the challenges of short- and long-term postoperative care.
- Explain the principles of treatment of Hirschsprung's disease and related disorders.
- Describe the diagnosis of Hirschsprung's disease and idiopathic constipation and the difference in their management.
- Understand indications for reoperative surgery.
- Discuss management of associated urologic and gynecologic problems.
- Understand the comprehensive management approach to cloacal exstrophy.
- Understand the use of the posterior sagittal approach for a variety of conditions.

This three-day intensive teaching course will examine the surgical treatment and management of pediatric anorectal and colorectal surgical problems including:

- Live operating room demonstrations with discussion
- Methods of evaluation of surgical techniques
- Anorectal malformations
- Cloacal malformations
- Cloacal exstrophy
- Prognosis of these deformities
- Hirschsprung's disease
- Idiopathic constipation
- Intestinal pseudo-obstruction

Pre and Postoperative Nursing Care for Children with ARM and Other Colorectal Conditions

A special one-day concurrent colorectal nursing session is also available (included with nursing registration fee). This small-group interactive workshop will include pre and postoperative nursing care, bowel management, urologic and gynecologic issues related to ARM, Hirschsprung's disease, idiopathic constipation and urinary reconstruction.
