Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center is pleased to announce the Summer Internship Program for science students interested in pursuing a Medical Career (MD, PhD, MD/PhD). This year we are happy to announce the addition of two new mentors from the University of Cincinnati in the adult care specialties of Internal Medicine and Intensive/Critical Care Medicine. The new University of Cincinnati based internships will be sponsored by the new Cincinnati Center for Clinical and Translational Science and Training Grant. A total of 16 positions are now available.

We offer these highly competitive paid internships to qualified applicants based on high school academic and leadership accomplishments. The internship program begins Monday, June 15th through August 6, 2009. Interns will work part-time (20 hours per week), and will be paid a maximum of \$1,168 (\$7.30/hr). The work schedule is flexible but attendance on Orientation Day is mandatory for all participants. **PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL APPLICANTS MUST BE GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL IN 2009.**


