

Dear Campers,

Thanks for registering for Camp Joyful Hearts. We have a lot of fun things planned for our camp week! I hope you are looking forward to it as much as we are ☺.

If you have questions before the morning of July 6th, call my voicemail at 513-636-7257. All campers need to arrive at Camp Joy between 9 am and 11am on Monday, July 6th. If you need directions, you can access them from our website. Go to Cincinnatichildrens.org/joyful-hearts. You can print directions from there, or from Camp Joy's website at JOEC.org. Check-in will be at the P & G Center.

During check-in our camp nurses or our medical director will review your camper's medical information with you. **If your camper has any special needs (diet or activity restrictions, allergies, etc) it is important to discuss it with them then.** Please remember that if your camper needs any health care equipment or monitors at home (like oxygen, or other supplies) you are responsible for providing this equipment for your child while they are at camp.

Pick-up will be on Friday, July 10th. You are welcome to attend our closing ceremony if you'd like. It will start at 1pm, in the P&G Center (the big building with the green roof closest to the parking lot). We will show a slideshow of photos taken during the week and talk a little about CJH. If you are unable to attend the closing ceremony, come to the P&G Center **no later than 2pm** to pick up your camper. If your camper is on any medications, don't forget to pick them up before you head for home.

Finally, our Thursday night marshmallow war is back by popular demand. Please bring a bag of miniature marshmallows to contribute to our ammunition stockpile, and an old pair of swim goggles or sunglasses for eye protection.
