Doctors from Cincinnati Children's met Beni while on a trip to Romania. He was small and frail and in constant pain. They soon determined that Beni had Hirschprung's disease—a lifethreatening gastrointestinal disorder. Our doctors performed surgery and he quickly began to gain weight. Today, Beni is an active boy with a sparkle in his eyes. He is very communicative, energetic and enjoys school.

Mikayla was having a difficult time in school and was unable to complete her first grade homework. After enrolling in a Cincinnati Children's research study focused on reading intervention, Mikayla's reading abilities improved. Now reading is her favorite pastime and she is excelling in school. Because of you I can be full of wonder.



She was involved in a study at Cincinnati Children's that showed brachial plexus patients' brains develop similarly to those of stroke patients. This helped her better understand her condition. 
Max, age 14


Zhania and Zion, ages 10 and 13 Because of you we can play all day.

Because of you I am healthy and happy.



Spencer, age 8


Because of you I can play in the woods with my brothers.

His skin is so fragile that just touching it can cause it to blister or tear. Shane was also born deaf and has bilateral cochlear implants. His family moved back to Cincinnati to be near his physicians at Cincinnati Children's. Shane is passionate about space and intends to work for NASA and help mankind explore and colonize Mars.



Katherine, age 4

At four months, Katherine was diagnosed with biliary atresia, a rare disease of the liver. Shortly thereafter she needed a liver transplant. Katherine's mom, Jessica, was a match and was able to successfully donate part of her liver to her daughter. Katherine and her twin brother, Kevin, are very close to their older brothers and now enjoy spending time playing together.

When Gabriel was six and began having seizures, his family took him to hospitals near their home in Puerto Rico, but doctors were unable to find what was wrong.
