

LEFTOVER TISSUE STORAGE DISCLOSURE

If you/your child has a test or procedure where tissue is taken, there may be extra tissue left over. Doctors usually keep this extra tissue in case a test needs to be run again or a new test needs to be run later.

Your/your child's extra tissue can also help doctors learn more about diseases. The tissue can help find better ways to diagnose, treat and prevent illnesses. After at least three months, the tissue may be used for research through Cincinnati Children's Discover Together Biobank. The tissue will be **de-identified**, which means your/your child's name and information will not be connected to it.

If a research study need more information, you may be contacted to talk about the study and decide if you/your child can take part.
