

# Medical Music Therapy Internship Cincinnati Children's Hospital, Main Campus

### **Internship Experience**

This internship is based out of our main medical campus in the Avondale neighborhood. The Main Burnet Campus is home to inpatient, outpatient, and surgical services; emergency and urgent care; and medical and scientific research endeavors.

Interns should expect to accumulate professional clinical experience through a diverse spectrum of multi-disciplinary and multi-cultural patient and family care. Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center incorporates the philosophy of family-centered care into every aspect of clinical practice and research.

As an intern, you can expect a wide array of experiences including individual, family, and group sessions. You will work with a variety of patient populations, diagnoses, and ages.

### **Internship Structure**

Interns will begin by orienting to CCHMC and the Division of Child Life & Integrative Care. Interns will then be introduced to the various clinical areas covered by each supervising music therapist. During months 2-4, the intern may have dedicated rotations in the following areas:

- Newborn Intensive Care Unit
- Pediatric Intensive Care Unit and Heart Institute
- Hematology/Oncology and Bone Marrow Transplant
- Neurology and Inpatient Rehabilitation
- Acute Care Units
- Home Hospice and Pediatric Palliative Care

During these rotations, interns will begin by observing, transition into co-leading with their supervisors, and when they demonstrate readiness, begin to lead sessions independently. Interns will also begin to build their individual caseload in collaboration with their supervisors.

Following these clinical rotations, interns will transition into working independently as they demonstrate readiness, maintaining a caseload of patients across the hospital system.



Other clinical and professional development experiences for interns include:

- One special project/assignment per month, all of which are designed to directly compliment interns' clinical work and have real-world professional application
- Weekly time dedicated to refining clinical musicianship
- Weekly supervision with internship director
- Frequent opportunities for in-the-moment supervision and feedback with all supervisors
- Peer supervision with multi-disciplinary students/interns
- Opportunities for co-treating groups and individual sessions with other members of the treatment team
- Participation in treatment team rounds
- Participation in music therapy team meetings and division staff meetings

#### **Logistics**

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Scheduled Hours	Monday – Friday, hours may vary depending on supervisors' schedules and other clinical needs.
Housing	Not provided, but many short-term leasing options are available in the Cincinnati area.
Meals	Not provided.
Transportation	The Metro bus service has a stop at the edge of campus property. Free parking is also available on site for interns with their own transportation.
Liability Insurance	Required. If the intern is affiliated with an academic institution, liability is often covered.
Stipend	Not provided.

Applications for a January start date are due **July 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:59 PM EST**Applications for a May or September start date are due **December 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:59 PM EST**
