

Cincinnati Children's Music Therapy Internship Fact Sheet

Now offering **TWO** music therapy internships: **Medical** (primary located at the Burnet Ave Medical Campus) **and Mental Health** (primary located at the College Hill Mental Health Campus and Liberty Medical Campus)

Internship Structure and Experience

Medical Music Therapy Internship

Internship is offered once a year, beginning in late summer early fall. This is a 6-month, 40 hour/week internship.

The application deadline is December 1st. After receiving a completed application, the music therapy internship director will contact you about setting up a Zoom interview.

At the medical campus, the music therapy team concentrates on the following inpatient units: Rehabilitation, Transitional Care, Bone Marrow Transplant, Hematology/Oncology, Cardiology, Cystic Fibrosis, Neurology, Neonatal Intensive Care, Cardiac Intensive Care, and Pediatric Intensive Care. Interns will have opportunities for group facilitation. Interns will have the opportunity to observe at the mental health campus and the in-home hospice program.

Mental Health Music Therapy Internship

Internship is offered once a year, beginning in late summer early fall. This is a 6month, 40 hour/week internship.

The application deadline is December 1st. After receiving a completed application, the music therapy internship director will contact you about setting up a Zoom interview.

At the mental health campus, the music therapy team serves children and adolescents in the inpatient and residential programs. Music Therapy occurs in group and individual settings. Interns will have the opportunity to observe at the medical campus and the in-home hospice program and gain clinical experience at one of our satellite medical campuses.

For both internships:

Interns should expect to accumulate professional clinical experience through a diverse spectrum of multi-disciplinary and multi-cultural patient and family care. Cincinnati



Children's Hospital Medical Center incorporates the philosophy of family-centered care into every aspect of clinical practice and research.

As an intern, you can expect a wide array of experiences including individual, family, and group sessions. You will work with a variety of populations and have the opportunity to focus on your population of interest. This internship also places an emphasis on the use of current technology and instruments.

Description of Professional Staff

The intern will be working with a tremendous array of medical professionals throughout the internship. They will interact regularly with our nine music therapists: Jennifer Seley, Elizabeth Harman, Brittney Knapp, Anthony Borzi, Ashley Ganis, Nicole Polara, Kendall Williams, Erin Seibert, and Bethany Rice. Other professionals include: Child Life Specialists, Social Workers, Chaplains, Physicians, Surgeons, Nurses, PCAs and PCFs, Administrative Consultants, Physical, Occupational, Recreational, and Respiratory Therapists, Psychologists, Psychiatrists, Volunteers, and all other medical center staff.

Intern Housing, Meals and Transportation Information

Housing is not currently offered by this facility, but there is a variety of short-term lease options available to interns in the area. Cincinnati Children's does not currently offer a stipend or meals for interns. For transportation needs, Cincinnati has an extensive bus system that provides services through greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky. More information will be provided upon the acceptance to the internship.
