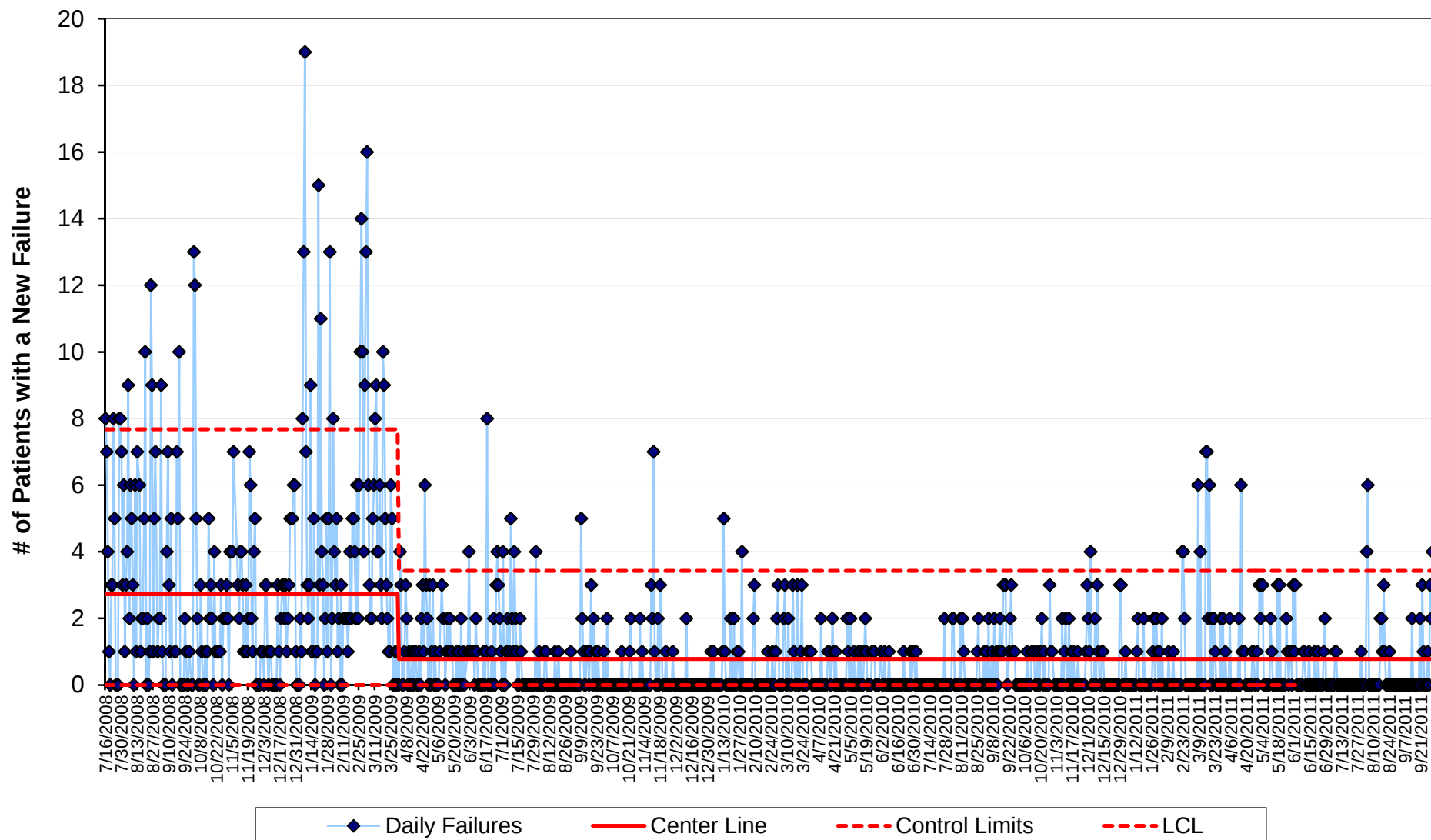
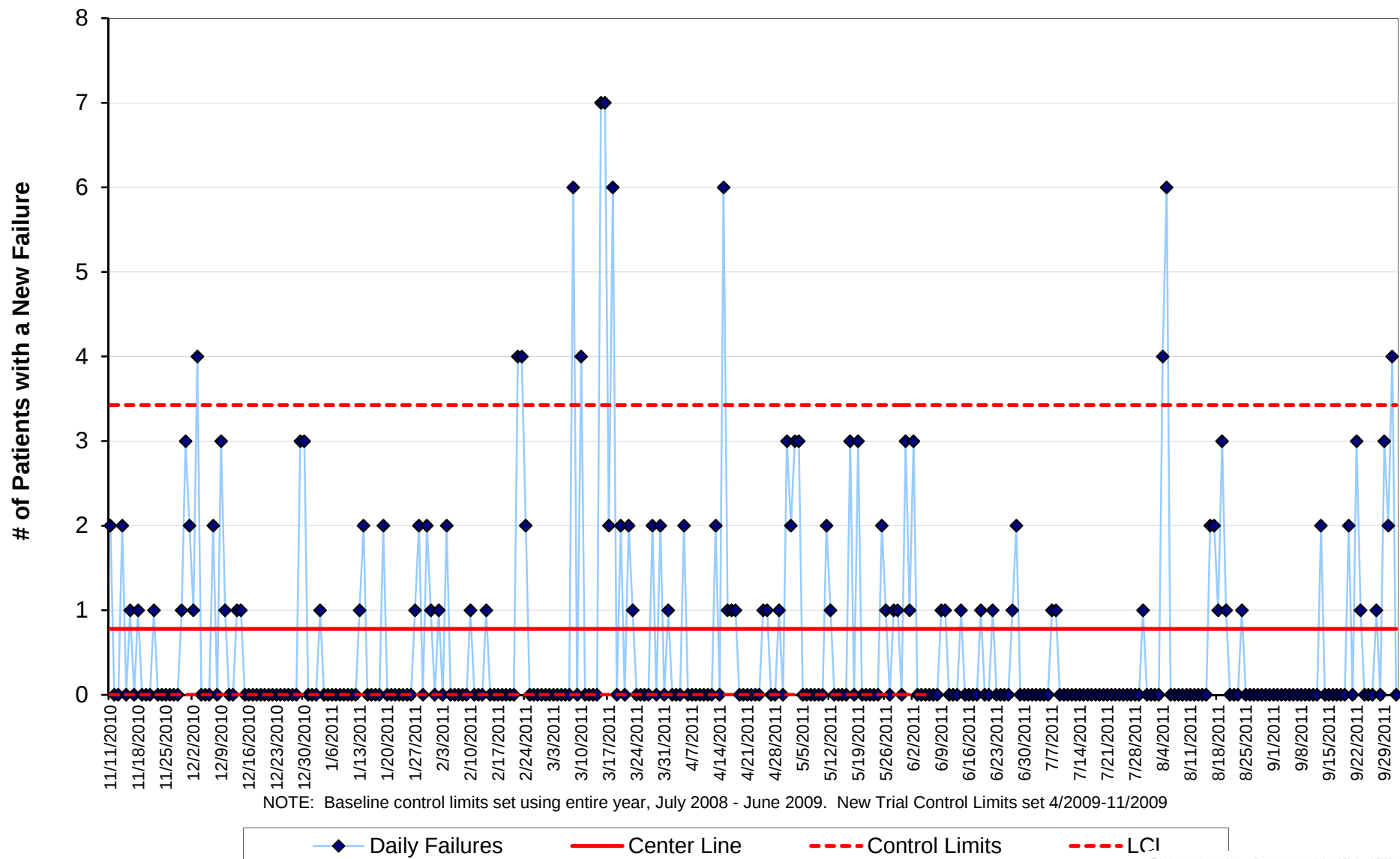

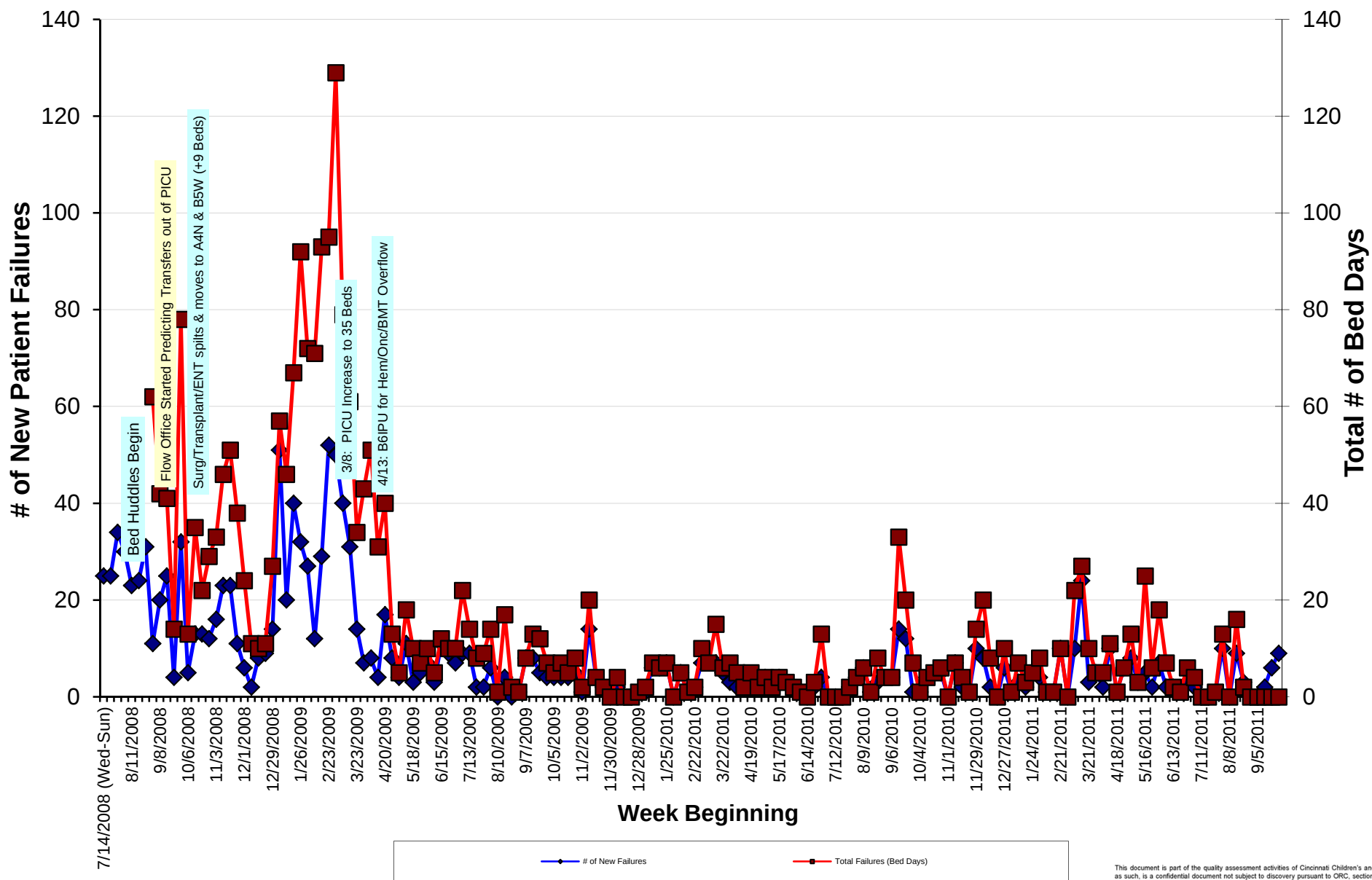


Daily Critical Flow Failures Zoomed View Patients

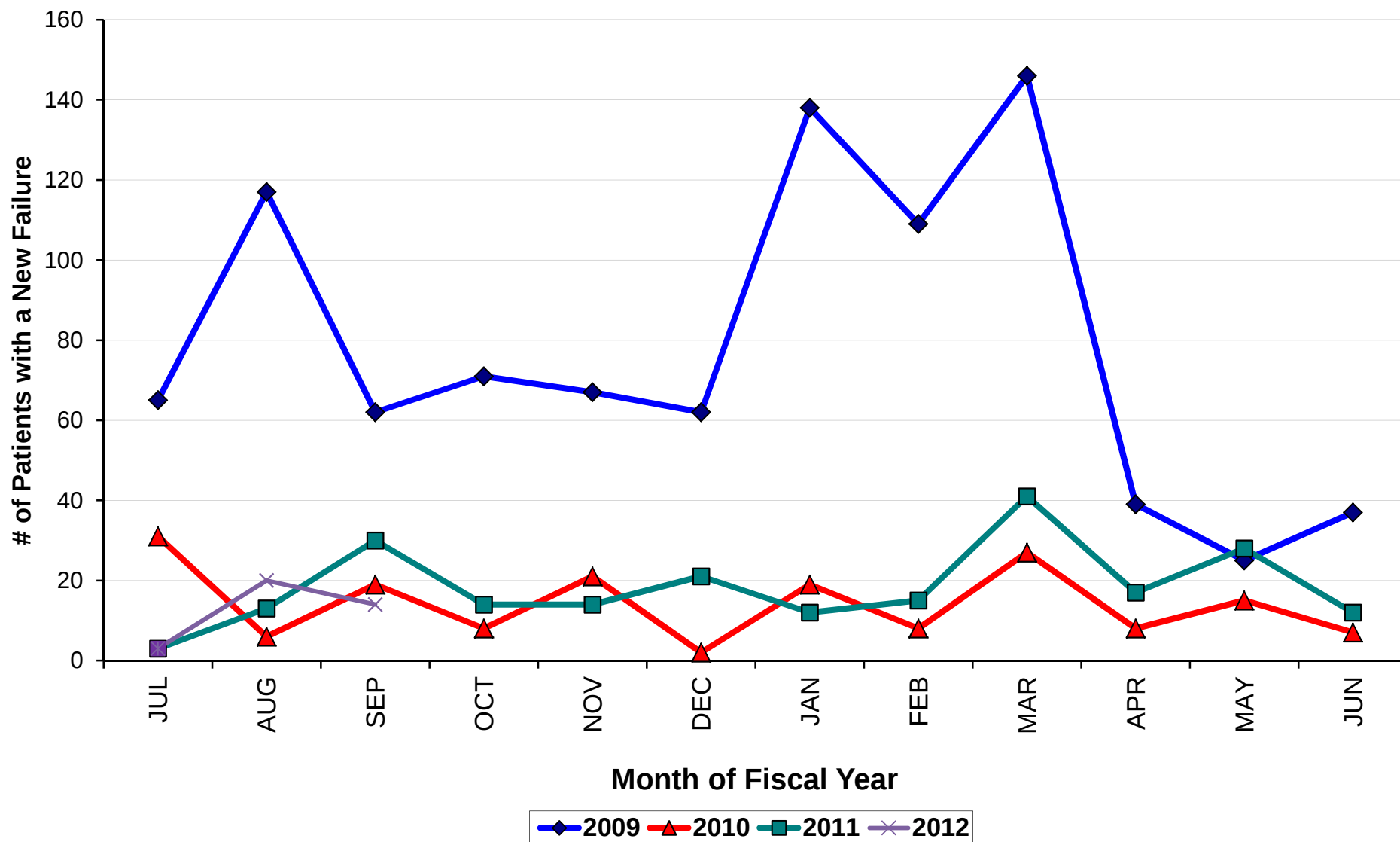

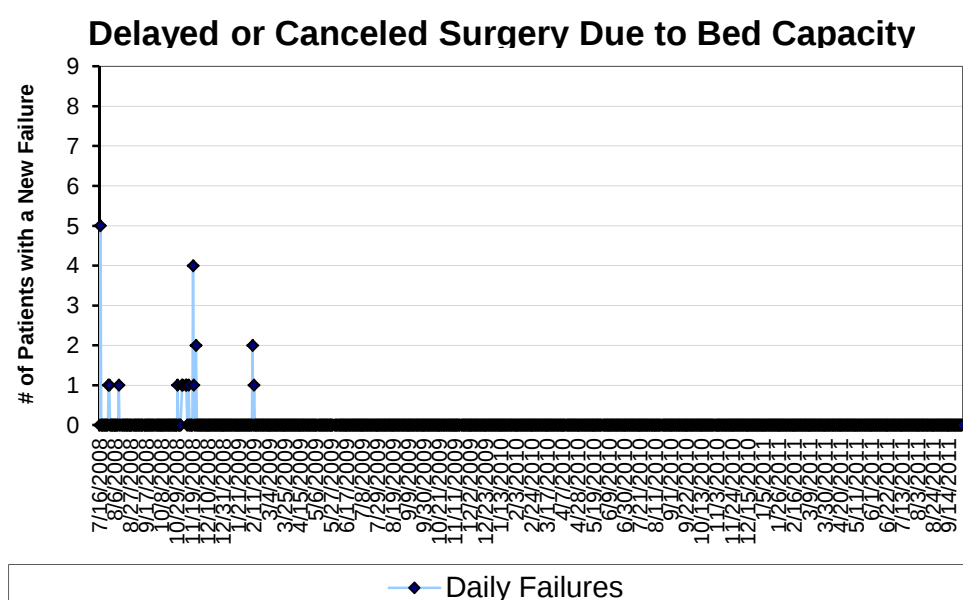

Critical Patient Flow Failures by Month

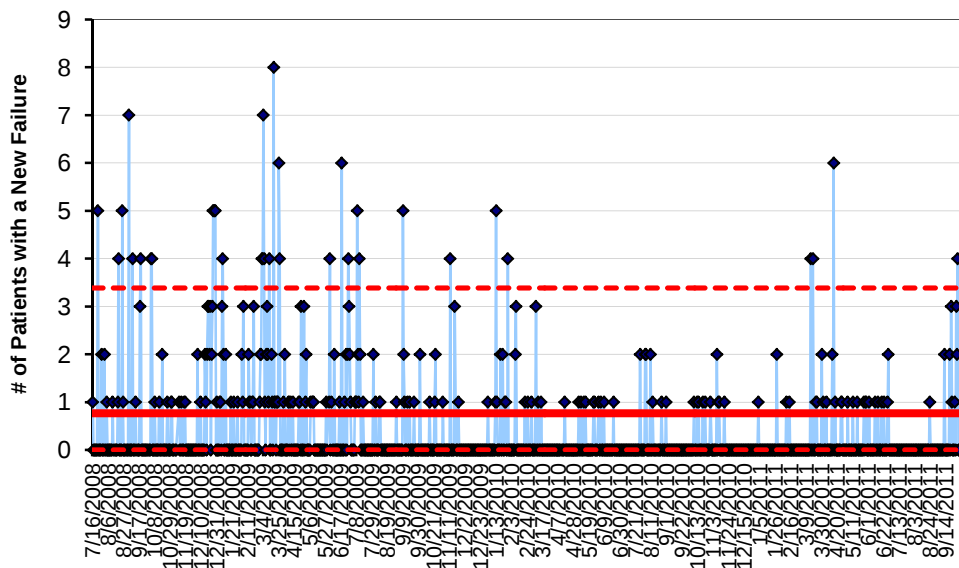

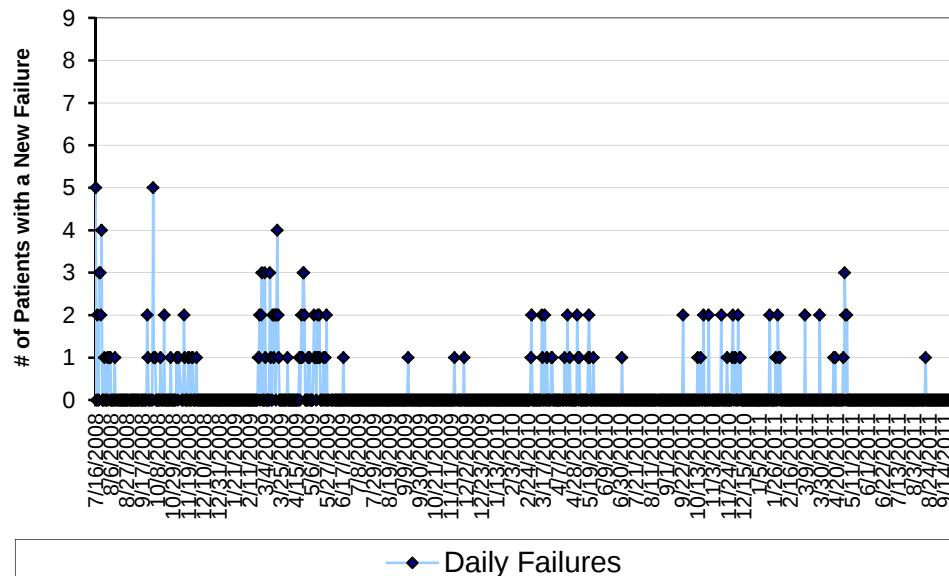

Patients who Remain in an ICU bed Longer than Medically Necessary b/c an Appropriate Bed is Not Available



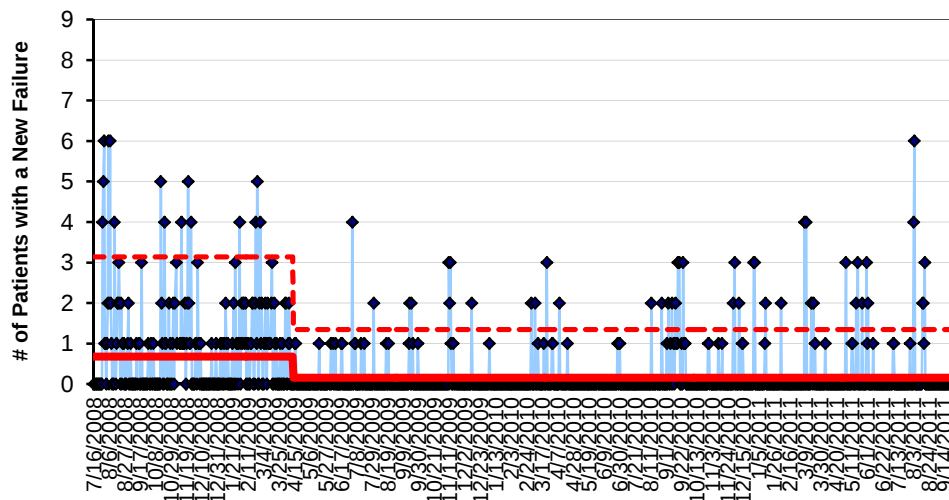
Unstable System - Control Limits are based on a stable system of failures

◆ Daily Failures

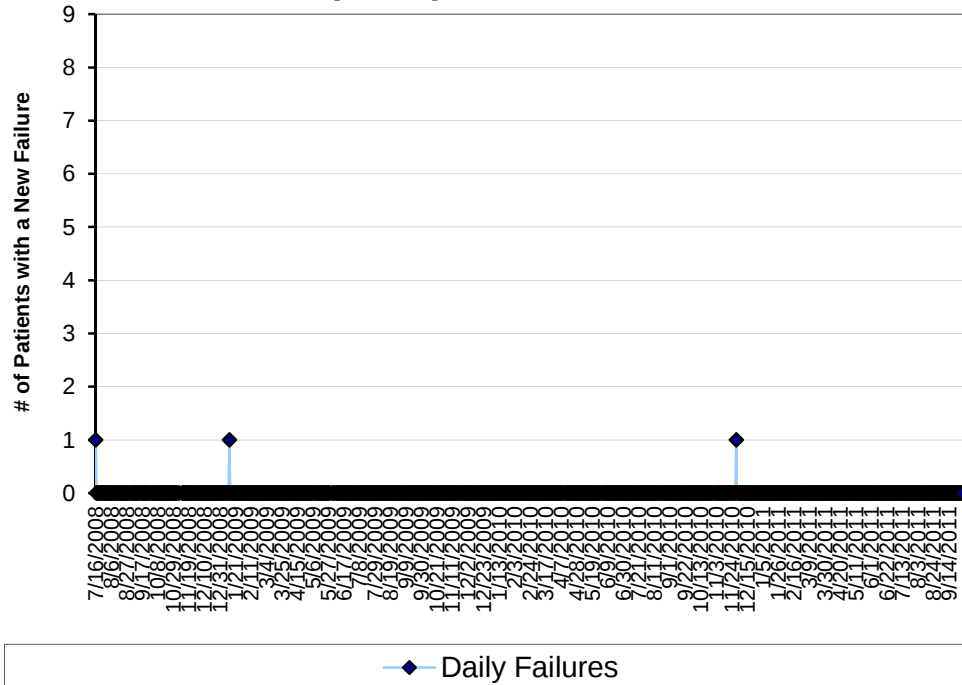
Hem/Onc/BMT Patients Placed Outside of their Primary Unit
