

Immunizations

In general, most immunizations are okay for children with rheumatic diseases. However, **some are not!** It depends on what medication your child is taking at the time. Children **cannot** get some immunizations if they are taking medications that can lower their immune system. These could include any of the following medicines:

Methotrexate
Steroids
Enbrel
Remicade
CellCept
Imuran
Cytoxan
Cyclosporin

Always check with your rheumatology nurse or doctor **before** your child gets any immunizations.
