Register Now for Parents on Point

Being a parent just might be the hardest job in the world—and yet it's one we don't go to school to learn how to do.

If you'd like to feel more confident as a parent, Parents on Point is the program for you!

Cincinnati Children's has partnered with Rockdale Academy and New Beginnings Church of the Living God to bring Parents on Point to the Avondale community. The program is proven to help parents feel more confident and to improve behavior in young children.

Parents on Point brings together parents and grandparents to build connections, share ideas and problem-solve common challenges parents face when raising children ages 2–5 years old. Parents take away from the sessions a 'bag of tricks' to use in common parenting situations. Twenty-Eight parents signed up to join the program this fall. The first group from Rockdale Academy graduated on January 25, 2018 after completing the 12-session program. Caregivers received certificates, awards and sported their Super Parent capes in recognition of their accomplishments.

"Everything we've been learning is all flowing together now, and they (my kids) are starting to realize it too."

"I'm just starting to be more patient. They (my children) should be taught the right way. I've got some more patience now."

Supplier and Workforce Diversity

If you live in Avondale, you may have noticed construction work is underway on the Northern Avenue garage located at Erkenbrecher and Harvey Avenues. Crews are working on the excavation, the deep foundations, and the shoring required along Erkenbrecher. Concrete work will begin shortly.

Cincinnati Children's and partner Messer Construction have a proven track record and commitment to workforce diversity and supplier diversity. The Northern Avenue garage project is exceeding the target of 50% supplier diversity, and on target to meet workforce diversity goals.

The garage will be under construction for at least the next year, with an estimated completion of December of 2018.
