

Construction Update: Critical Care Building

What's Happening Onsite

- This month, crews start on Level 6 of the Critical Care Building. It will house the Cardiac Intensive Care Unit and nearly double its current size, bringing our total beds for the unit to 48 to serve children and adults born with heart conditions.
- The exterior of the building begins to take shape with the installation of glass panels on Lower Level 1 and 2.



Traffic Alert

- Concrete and construction vehicles entering and leaving the site could create backups. Flaggers will be onsite to help direct traffic.

Construction Jobs for the Community

- After completing the Building Value work training program, currently 21 men and women from the Uptown area have full-time jobs in construction and related fields. Eight additional trainees are currently enrolled.
