We followed the butterflies on the floor to the Audiology department.



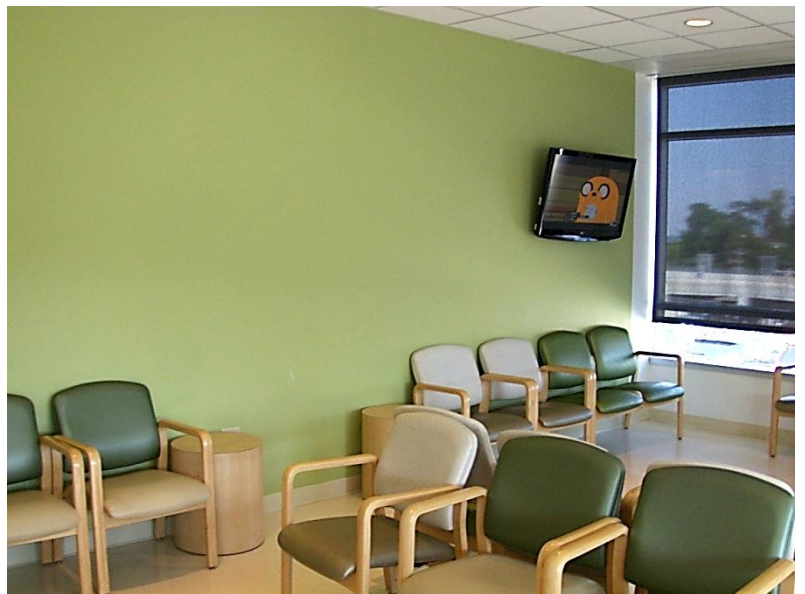


We checked in at the desk and had a seat in the waiting room.





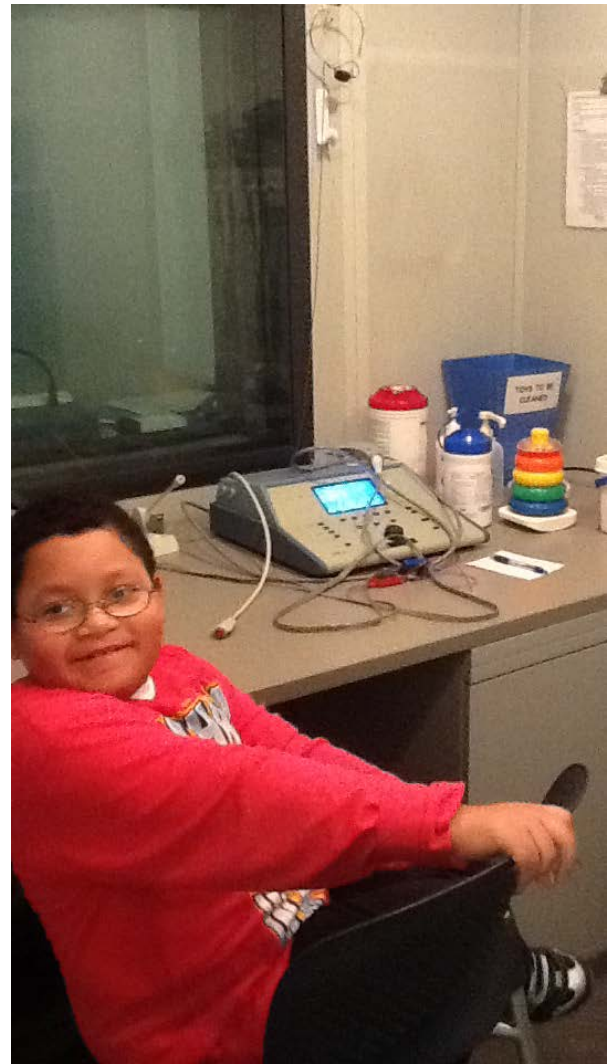
We waited in the waiting room.





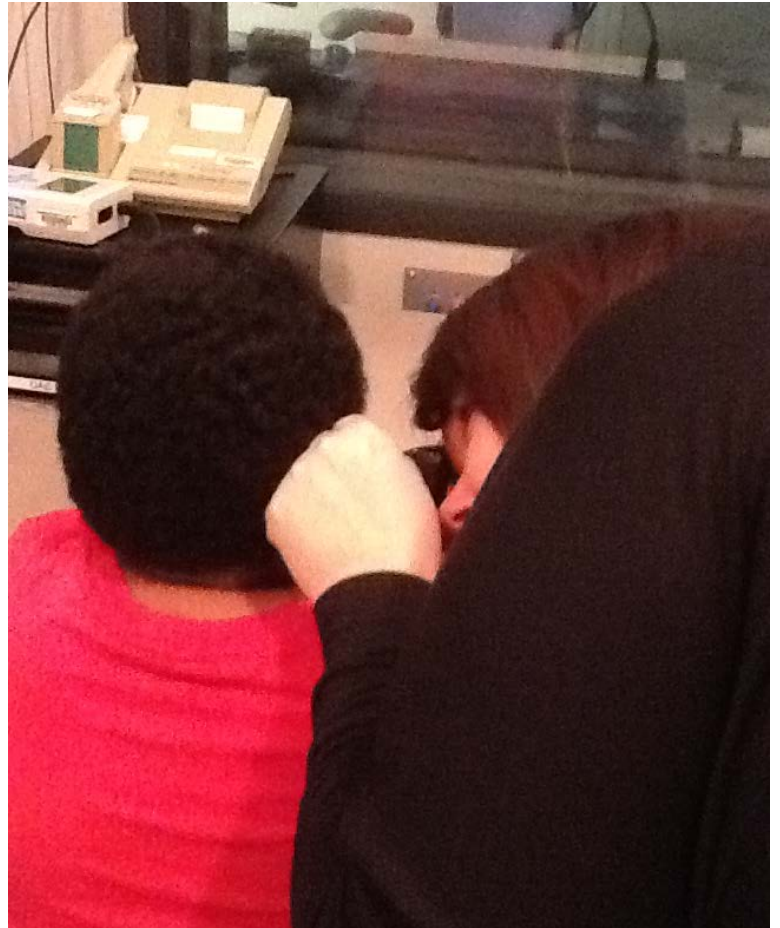
When it was my turn, the audiologist came to the waiting room and called my name.





We went into a special room with a window, called a booth. There were butterflies on the door.

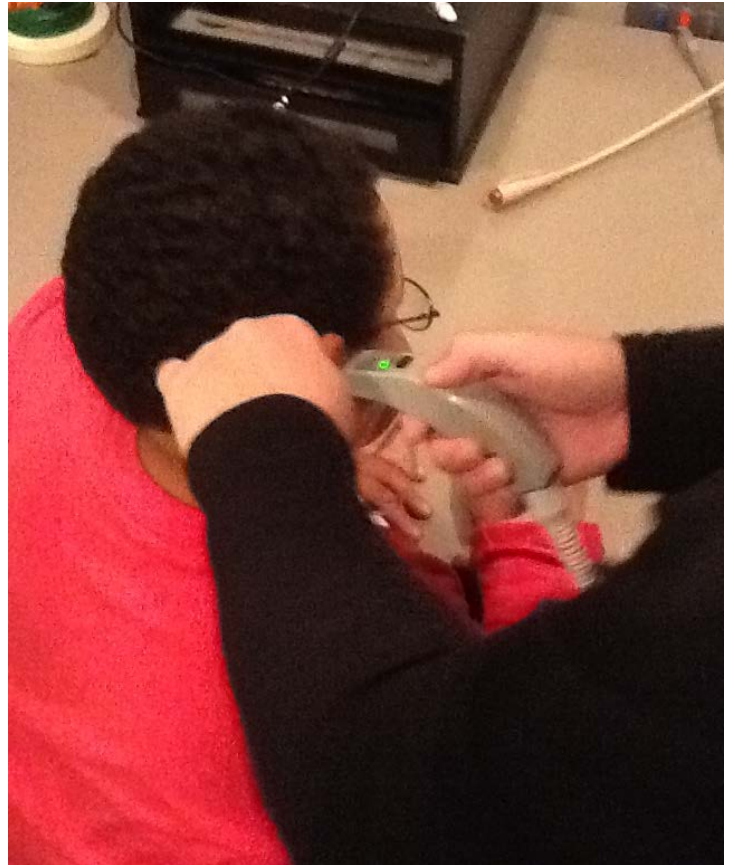
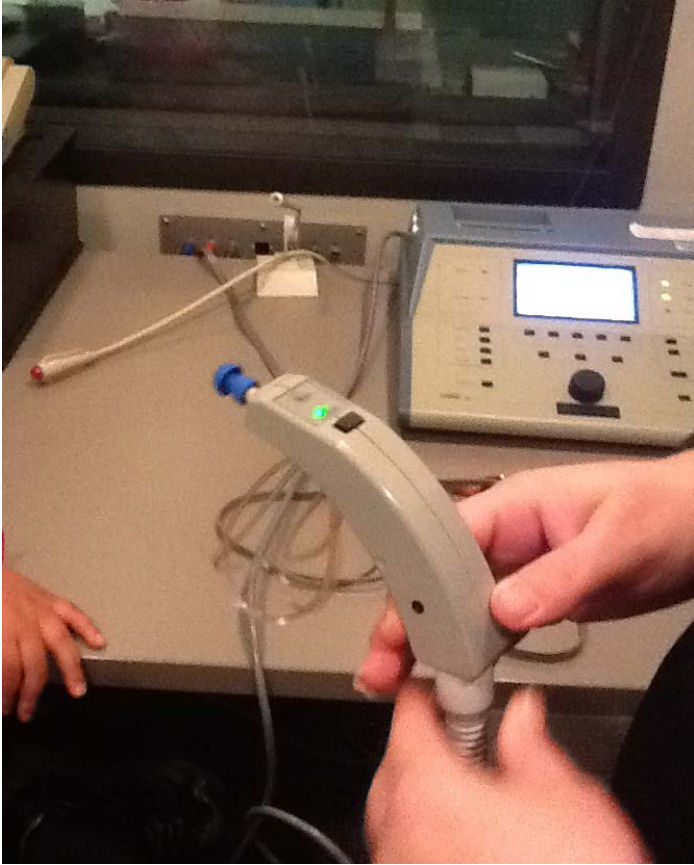
This is an otoscope.



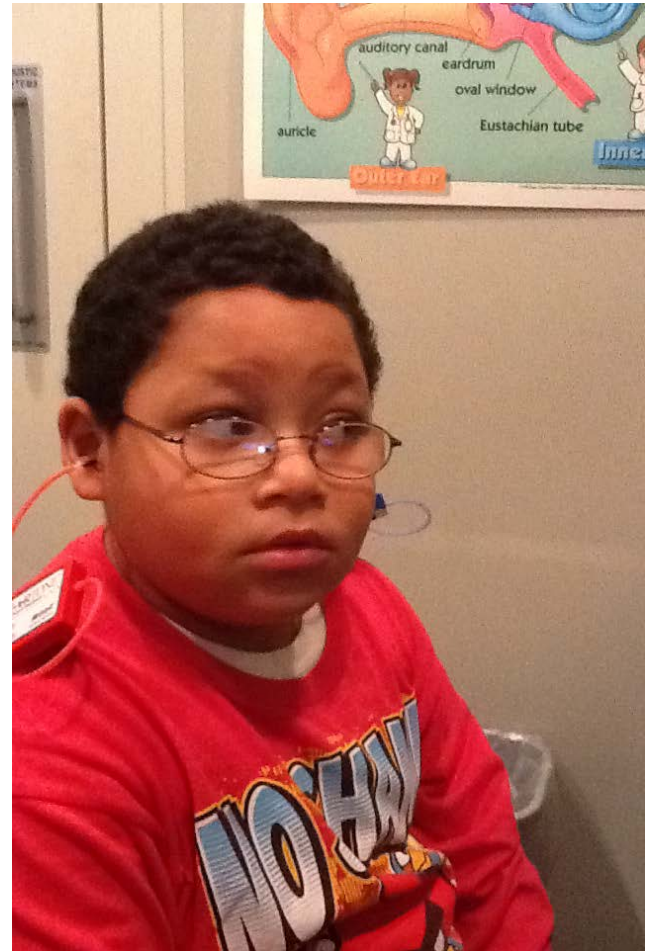
When the test began, I sat in a chair and the audiologist looked in my ears with an otoscope.
