# **IMPORTANT PARENT REMINDERS**

## What is needed from you for your child's school year 2019-2020!

## 1. Diabetes School Orders and Insulin Dose Verification for Insulin Administration at School

- 2. <u>Insulin Dose Verification</u>: Parents are responsible for completing the Insulin Dose Verification form at the beginning of each school year and every time there is an insulin dose change.
  - During clinic visits complete Parent Section, have your diabetes provider sign the form and then take to your child's school.
  - In between clinic visits complete the Parent Section and have form faxed to the Diabetes Center at **513**-**636-9677**. The form will be verified and faxed back to your child's school.
- 3. <u>School Meeting</u>: Schedule a meeting with your child's school personnel every year before returning to school or upon diagnosis. Review the Diabetes School Orders, Insulin Dose Verification and the Individual Management Plan for caring for your child at school with:
  - <u>School Nurse</u> (if you do not have a school nurse ask the school who will be helping with your child's diabetes and include them in the meeting)
  - <u>Other school personnel</u>: nurse's aide, administrative support staff, teacher, principal, food service manager, bus driver, counselor, physical education teacher/coach

### 4. Diabetes Supplies for School:

- Determine an area to store diabetes supplies and perform blood glucose testing with school personnel.
- Arrange a plan for school personnel to report blood glucose results to parents.
- Designate an area to store items used to treat low blood glucose levels.
