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Are housing needs, public benefit denials, school problems, or other legal issues making it hard for you to keep your child healthy?

If the answer is “yes” ask your doctor or social worker about *Child HeLP*.

HOUSING Problems Affect Your Child's Health

Do you need help with:

- Eviction
- Poor housing conditions
- Foreclosure

A child needs to live in decent housing.



SCHOOL Problems Affect Your Child's Health

Do you need help with:

- Expulsion
- Special Education
- Enrollment

A child who attends school and receives needed services and supports is more likely to learn.

FAMILY Problems Affect Your Child's Health

Do you need help with:

- Custody
- Emotional or physical abuse
- Family violence

A stable and safe home promotes a child's positive behaviors, emotional development and social skills.



BENEFIT Problems Affect Your Child's Health

Do you need help with:

- Medicaid
- Food stamps
- OWF
- Child care
- Social Security/SSI
- Unemployment
- Veteran's benefits

Families need enough resources to meet the needs of their children.

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
