Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center is pleased to announce the 2018 Summer Internship Program for science students interested in pursuing a Medical Career (MD, MD/PhD, PhD). A total of 10 positions will be available with mentors from CCHMC working in different areas of Pediatrics and clinical research. Please note that this program is **not** for students interested in a Nursing career.

We offer these highly competitive paid internships to qualified applicants based on high school academic and leadership accomplishments. The Internship program runs from Wednesday, June 13th through Tuesday, August 7, 2018. Interns will work part-time (20 hours per week), and will be paid a maximum of \$1,328 (\$8.30/hr). The work schedule is flexible but attendance on Orientation Day, Wednesday June 13<sup>th</sup>, is mandatory for all participants. **PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL APPLICANTS MUST BE GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL IN 2018.**

Please note that applications are now **online** only. Students interested in applying for this program must complete the online application and provide the requested support information. Applications must be completed no later than **5pm, on Friday, March 15, 2018**. Reference letters must be submitted separately to Lisa Higgins.

This internship is a very competitive program, but also a very exciting opportunity for students who are motivated to learn more about careers in pediatric medicine, and biomedical research.
