Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center is pleased to announce the Summer Internship Program for science students interested in pursuing a Medical Career (MD, MD/PhD, PhD). A total of 15 positions will be available with faculty mentors from CCHMC working in different areas of Pediatrics and clinical research. Please note that this program is **not** for students interested in a Nursing career.

We offer these highly competitive paid internships to qualified applicants based on high school academic and leadership accomplishments. The Internship program begins on Wednesday, June 12th through Tuesday, August 6, 2019. Interns will work part-time (20 hours per week), and will be paid a maximum of \$1,368 (\$8.55/hr). The work schedule is flexible but attendance on Orientation Day, Wednesday June 12<sup>th</sup>, is *mandatory* for all participants. **PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL APPLICANTS MUST BE GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL IN 2019.**

Students interested in applying for this program must submit a completed **online** application and provide the requested support information. Please note that applications must be completed no later than **5pm, Monday, March 18, 2019**. Reference letters must be submitted separately to Lisa Higgins.
